IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

Full Load Information:	60-74 points per semester. The number of courses you must take depends on the credit value of your selected courses. See chart in the Office for International Study.
Smith College Deadline for Application to Host School/University:	Fall Semester: April 1st, Spring Semester: September 1st
Payments (Students must confirm with their host school/university that Smith is responsible for all tuition, room and board expenses)	
Tuition Deposit Required?	No
Accommodation Deposit Covered by Smith?	Yes, notify the University Flat's office that Smith will be paying accommodation costs and deposit will be included on invoice to Smith
Tuition:	Tuition Invoicing sent directly to Smith Please Note: Insurance Fees are waivable so Smith will not cover them.
Accommodation:	Accommodation Invoicing sent directly to Smith. Students need to be in direct contact with the Study Abroad Coordinator to receive a stipend to cover the utility costs.
Accommodation Expectations:	Must apply for university-affiliated housing by posted deadline. Students must apply for accommodation in the University Flats. Students should choose "mid-range" priced accommodation - not the most expensive and not the cheapest, but somewhere in between. In most cases, mid-range will be rooms in flats where you may or may not have your own bathroom (aka: en suite) and where you'll have to cook for yourself (aka: self-catered).
Accommodation Application Deadline at University of Otago:	For Semester 1 (Feb-June): November 1st; For Semester 2 (July-Nov): March 1st
Visa:	All students applying directly to host schools/universities will be required to obtain their own visa. It is very important that students begin this process early, as it may take a several months to obtain. This is especially true for International Students. We recommend students use a service, such as, Perry International www.perryvisa.com
