Description: 18 college graduates will serve as full-time Senate staff for 11 months. The fellowship program is sponsored jointly by the state Senate and the Center for California Studies at California State University, Sacramento (CSUS).

Description: Fellows participate in academic seminars, and work as regular, full time staff in executive offices in the capitol. Applicants are university or college graduates, from all academic disciplines, and may have advanced degrees. Finalists must be willing to interview in Sacramento or Los Angeles.

Description: Judicial Administration Fellows serve as full time professional staff in Judicial branch offices. Fellows earn 12 graduate credits for successful completion of seminar and field placement. Applicants for the Fellowship must hold a B.A. or B.S. The program provides a stipend and pays for university enrollment and student fees.
