CET Grant Proposals

Robert Davis gave the committee a brief history on the charge of CET in granting funding on proposals. Then each proposal was discussed and voted on as follows:

- Laura Katz − Biology − Macintosh requested for teaching lab − request for \$2219.00 approved but the committee voted to increase grant to \$3039.00 to purchase FCAP standard Mac.
- □ Robert Burger Geology Digital video storage request for \$858.00 funding approved
- □ Donald Siegel ESS ESS camera and DVD-RW drive request for \$1000 considered innovative funding approved
- Robert Newton Geology Multi-media mapping hardware and software request for \$4344 considered very creative with many potential applications need specification of "other" expense funding approved once expense is specified
- James Johnson ESS Exercise intensity monitor request for \$5206 funding approved - increased to \$6095 to bring the laptop to FCAP standard
- □ Rodger Blum Dance Dance technology hardware and software upgrades request for \$6864.95 funding approved
- □ Gary Niswonger Art CPU, monitor & Infocus projector request for \$10700 The committee felt that some of this request should be handled by the department, that Herb and Charles would talk to the Art

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department about funding the projector – funding of approximately \$4000 approved for a CPU and display

- Tony Caldanaro Geology Geology iBook request for \$2032 for new laptop to use with the Infocus – funding approved
- Barbara Lattanzi Art Digital gathering equipment request for \$16810 the committee felt that this would be a valuable purchase for the college and that when not in use by the art department this equipment should be part of the Media Services equipment pool funding approved
- Dwight Pogue Art 40" scanner request for \$11000 the committee felt that this should be partially funded by the Art department Charles will speak with them and find out how much they are prepared to fund as with all equipment, this would be property of Smith and available for others on campus to use. Funding approved assuming departmental assistance

The total of these grants is \$58042.95 minus the Art department's contribution to the Dwight Pogue proposal.
