

SAMPLE – Tenure-Track

Assistant Professor of Art

The Department of Art at Smith College invites applications for a tenure-track position as Assistant Professor of Art (Printmaking and Drawing). Appointment begins July 2011. We seek an artist working in printmaking and drawing, with expertise in intaglio, and experience in at least one other area of printmaking. Facilities currently support a full range of printmaking practices including intaglio, stone lithography, offset, and photo-printmaking. Work should demonstrate an expansive and critical approach to contemporary artistic practice, compatible with the interdisciplinary emphasis of a liberal arts college. Four courses per year (including: intaglio and drawing, at least one introductory-level course, and periodic responsibility for teaching an advanced visual studies seminar in rotation with other faculty). M.F.A. or M.A. required, and at least one year of teaching experience beyond the teaching-assistant level.
