The purpose of this memo is to share with you some of the dining information that will be available for you during Passover beginning, Saturday, April 19th at sundown through Sunday April 27th at sundown.

Passover meals will be available from our Kosher Kitchen located in Cutter/Ziskind House. Kosher for Passover foods will be prepared in our meat kitchen and we will provide a parve alternative (non-meat alternative). Meals will be served on disposable china and flatware.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: *These meals will be provided only to those who sign up in advance.* Each student should sign up individually to ensure an accurate count. Please show up for the meals you reserve. If you are unable to attend a meal you reserve, please let us know by contacting the Kosher kitchen or emailing us at passoverfood@smith.edu. Reservations should be sent with the attached form to passoverfood@smith.edu or given to Joe Morse in the Kosher Kitchen by Friday March 28th. Passover can be a stressful time for our staff and it is not possible to increase our food orders once the holiday begins. So while it may be possible to make last minute reservations, we need your cooperation and communication to meet your needs during this special time. You should receive a confirmation email with the meals you reserve.

Please note other details:

1. The Kosher line will be providing lunch and dinner (except for the two Seder meals on 4/19 and 4/20) for the eight days of Passover. See Dining Services web page for meal times and menus
2. Since the Kosher Kitchen will close Friday 4/18 to begin preparing Passover, meals for dinner 4/18 and lunch 4/19 will be pre-prepared and available by reservation and pick-up. Please contact Joe Morse directly in the Kosher Kitchen for these meals.
3. We will have the Ziskind beau parlor available for all Passover meals.
4. The Cutter/Ziskind main kitchen will be offering breakfast items for those avoiding leavened products; this will include breakfast pastries, cereals and matzoh brei.
5. (it must be noted that food prepared for breakfast meals in the main kitchen are not kosher for Passover.)
6. The Kosher Co-op, located in Dawes House, will also be offering Passover items during breakfast for any student who is interested. The Rabbi and the cooks will make every effort to have all meals meet the dietary laws of the holiday.
7. All dining rooms will have Matzoh and hard boiled eggs available during all meals
