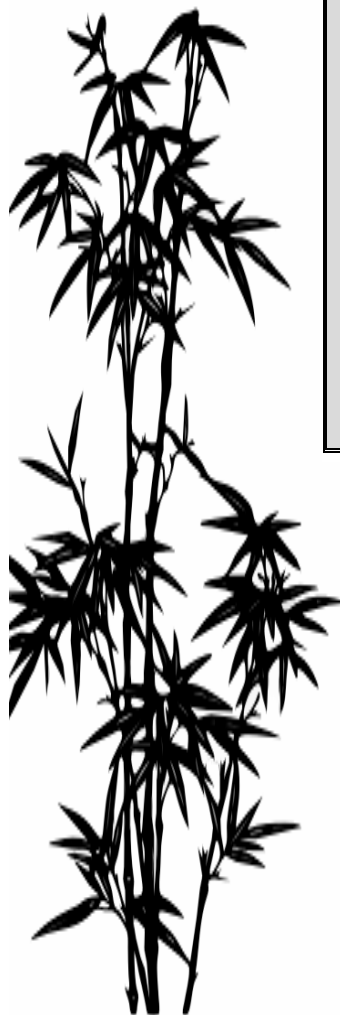

It provides content and resources for teaching about China, Japan, and Korea.

Benefits:

Requirements:

- Intend to teach at least two more years.
- Attend all sessions in their entirety, complete all readings, and assignments.
- Attend a follow-up session in February, 2012.
- Develop an implementation plan for incorporating material presented into your teaching.
- Obtain written support from your school administrator stating the school's willingness to retain the study of East Asia in the curriculum.
