



Botanic Garden of Smith College Volunteer Program

Thanks for your interest in volunteering at the Botanic Garden of Smith College. Volunteers work on a number of projects at the Botanic Garden, although mostly we need volunteers to lead school group tours through the greenhouses and gardens as well as staffing our reception area and exhibition gallery. Other projects might include developing thematic tours, providing hospitality for events such as the opening of the bulb show, and assisting with exhibitions and the international seed exchange. Please note, **volunteers do not do any hands-on horticultural work.** (Union rules simply do not permit it.)

Volunteer training sessions are held once a year. The next three day session (all day 9:00 am to 4:00 pm each day) will take place January 21, 22, and 23, 2009 and will be followed up with weekly training tours in February and monthly meetings on the third Wednesday morning of each month. The training will include a history of the Botanic Garden; tours of conservatories; some basic botany and horticulture; commercial, medicinal and food plants of the Lyman Plant House, and how to guide visitors and school groups. In exchange for the training, we expect you to volunteer at the Botanic Garden for at least one full year, including attending the monthly meetings, which offer the opportunity to continue to learn more about different areas of the Botanic Garden.
