HOW TO SCAN 35 MM SLIDES

PREPARE FOR SCANNING

1. Turn on the scanner
2. Open **Adobe Photoshop 7.0** by double clicking on the desktop icon.[]
3. In Photoshop, click on **File**, then **Import**, then **Silverfast Epson**.
4. The **Silverfast** scanning software will open.

THE SCANNING PROCESS

1. Lift the scanner lid to find the **white pad** on the underside of the lid
2. Remove the **white pad** using the top handle
3. Place the **black slide tray** on the scanner bed.
4. Align the **white arrow** in the corner of the tray with the **top right corner** of the scanner bed.
5. Place the slides in the tray **face down**.
6. Close the Scanner lid
7. If you have not already opened the Silverfast Scanning software from Adobe, do so now.
8. On the Silverfast scanning software under the tab marked **General** you should select the following settings...
 - Scan mode – normal**
 - Original – transparency**
 - Pos/neg – positive**
9. Under the tab marked **Frame** you should select the following settings
 - Scan type – 48-24 bit**
 - Filter – none**
 - Image type – standard**
 - Dpi – 2000**
10. Select the **Prescan** button and images of the slides will appear.
11. Use the frame to select the area around **one slide**.
12. Select the **Scan RBG** button.
13. The scanned image will open in Adobe. Repeat for each desired slide.
14. Proceed to **HOW TO USE PHOTOSHOP instructions**.
