

**Frank R. Baskind, M.S.W., Ph.D.** – Virginia Commonwealth University  
Since January 1992, Dr. Baskind has served as Dean and Professor of Social Work in Virginia Commonwealth University's School of Social Work. From 1980-85, Dr. Baskind served as the Associate Head of Human Services and Social Work Programs and Founding Director and Associate Professor of the Undergraduate Social Work Program at the University of Tennessee, College of Liberal Arts, in Knoxville. Dr. Baskind served as dean of the School of Social Work at Southern Connecticut State University from 1985-88. In 1987, he also was acting dean of the university's School of Arts and Sciences. Following these posts, he was appointed Dean of Social Work and Human Services from 1988 – 1991 at Southern Connecticut State University. The author of numerous journal articles, Dr. Baskind has lectured around the world on a variety of issues including trends in social work practice, strengthening aging and gerontology education for social work, and using partnerships to initiate institutional change for minority student retention. He has been a consultant to the Christian Children's Fund for projects in Kosovo, Ukraine, and Belarus and has worked with Council on Social Work Education staff on John A. Hartford Foundation funded curriculum and faculty development initiatives. He is immediate past president of the Council on Social Work Education and a retired Lieutenant Colonel, USAR, and recipient of the Bronze Star Medal for service in Vietnam.
