Rev. John P. Oliver, D.Min., is currently the Chief of the Chaplain Service and Clinical Pastoral Education Supervisor at the Association for Clinical Pastoral Education (ACPE) at the Durham VA Medical Center. The Rev. Dr. Oliver holds a Doctor of Ministry from Columbia Theological Seminary and Master of Divinity from Southwestern Baptist Seminary in Fort Worth, TX. He is a certified supervisor for the Association for Clinical Pastoral Education, Inc. and a board certified chaplain via the National Association of VA Chaplains. A member of the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship, Rev. Dr. Oliver is the author of "Balancing Religion and Spirituality in Health Care" published in HealthPower and Prevention News in November 2003 and subsequently printed in the January-February 2004 edition of the Military Chaplains' Association and the Naval Education and Training Command (NETC) Newsletter.
