The Project Coach (PC) Fellowship provides an opportunity for aspiring educators and coaches to gain deep first-hand experience mentoring youth in an out of school time setting. PC Fellows work toward their MAT degree or MS in Exercise and Sport Studies by attending Smith College classes and working 12 hours/week as an assistant in Project Coach, a sports-based youth development program that links Smith students with youth in Springfield, MA.

Fellowship requirements:

- Student teaching (MAT) or classes (ESS) in the mornings (8am-1pm)
 - Classes or student teaching in the afternoon
- Project Coach Academy, or after-school programming (3-7 pm, 4 days a week)

This competitive fellowship provides an academic year tuition waiver.
