2. Resume
3. Statement indicating your motivation and objectives in undertaking the post-baccalaureate in mathematics. (Reflect on your mathematics, comment on mathematics courses you have taken, and indicate what you hope to accomplish as a result of participation in this post-baccalaureate program.)
4. Three signed letters of recommendation, including at least two from mathematics faculty. You are responsible for obtaining your own references. Letters should be mailed (or e-mailed) directly to the office of Graduate and Special Programs.
