Medical Services:

Doctors, nurse practitioners and nurses provide routine health and wellness care such as sports and travel physicals; general check-ups; clearance exams for volunteer work or internships; reproductive and sexual health exams; contraception; related health education. We also provide problem-oriented care for sickness and injuries.

We have a lab on site.

Counseling Services:

Our mental health counselors and psychiatrists provide ongoing private and group counseling to support mental health needs and medication management as appropriate.

Wellness Education:

Our wellness team has a comprehensive program to help students live full balanced happy lives. There are opportunities for individual advice on alcohol education, smoking cessation, and other health concerns. Students may schedule a consultation with our nutritionist.

Fast Facts for ALL Students

- 1. We can take care of most medical & mental health needs here on campus free and confidentially.
- 2. There is no office visit charge to be seen at the medical or counseling service (See below regarding insurance).
- 3. All care is confidential (Exception: life-threatening, dangerous emergencies).
- 4. We communicate with you through our patient portal. You will be notified by email that you have a secure message then log onto the patient portal to read the message (www.smith.edu/health/medicat.html).
- 5. We can help 24/7! Even if we are closed! If you are sick or injured and need medical advice or care, you can reach a nurse or counselor to help you.
- 6. Some appointments can be booked online in the patient portal (www.smith.edu/health/medicat.html).
- 7. Campus Police can provide urgent transportation for sick or injured students.
- 8. Wellness brings super programs to you, has drop-in hours, and meets with students by appointment.
- 9. Same day and next day appointments are available. Crisis appointments are available.
- 10. Pre-Register at Cooley Dickinson Hospital 413-582-2800 before having any tests or lab work. (See reverse side for instructions for obtaining your insurance card/ID number).

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Smith College Health Insurance Plan

On Campus Health Care

• The Smith College Insurance Plan covers your on-campus office visits and most lab tests and vaccines without charge.

Off Campus Care

- Visits with community providers or specialists are covered by Smith insurance (\$10 copay/in-network).
- There are co-pays (\$15/\$30/\$50) for most prescription medications. There is no co-pay for most generic contraception.
- Yearly eye exams are covered, glasses are not.
- Routine dental care is not covered.
- Yearly deductible: \$150 for in-network services; and \$300 for out-of-network services may be applied to lab work and tests.
- Emergency Room visits (without admission) have a \$250 charge after insurance coverage. Go to Urgent Care first, if possible.
- Urgent Care copays are \$10 per visit. If radiology and labs are done, they are subject to a \$150 annual deductible.

Insurance Cards

- To print a copy of your verification letter:
 - 1. Go to www.gallagherstudent.com/smith
 - 2. On the left toolbar, click 'Account Home'
 - 3. Log in to your account.
 - 4. You will be redirected to the "Account Home' page, then click on 'Verification Letter' under 'Coverage History'.
- To request a copy of your BCBS Student Blue Insurance card, call 800-456-3753, option 3. You will receive your ID card in approximately one week.

What If I Don't Have Smith Insurance?

- You can still be seen on campus at The Schacht Center for Health and Wellness.
- Medical, Mental Health, and Wellness Service appointments are available free of charge to all students.
- MOST care at The Schacht Center is free of charge.
- There are charges for vaccines, labs, and supplies, which may not be covered by private insurance.
- Any charges incurred will be billed to your student financial account. We will mail a claim form to your campus mailbox which you will need to submit to your insurance company.
- Check with your plan regarding in-network local coverage.
- Students are responsible for any charges not covered by their plan.
