Updated Meningococcal Disease and Vaccination Requirements for College Students Beginning Fall of 2018



All newly enrolled full-time students 21 years of age and younger will be required to show documentation of a dose of MenACWY vaccine administered on or after their 16th birthday, regardless of housing status.

- All full-time students 21 years of age and younger must receive the Information and Waiver Form for Students, which will be revised to reflect the updated requirements for 2018, AND have one of the following:
 - o documentation of a dose of MenACWY vaccine received on or after their 16th birthday **OR**
 - o a medical or religious exemption for meningococcal vaccine **OR**
 - o a signed meningococcal vaccine waiver.
- Meningococcal B vaccine does not fulfill the requirement for meningococcal vaccine.

Summary of Current and Future Meningococcal Requirements for College Students

Current Requirements (in effect for the 2017-18 school year)	Future Requirements (in effect for the 2018-19 school year)
One dose MenACWY for all newly enrolled full-time residential students	One dose of MenACWY for newly enrolled full-time students 21 years of age or younger (<22 years of age) received on or after the 16 th birthday, regardless of housing status.
