Smith College Timeline for Confirmation of Acceptance to Host School/University:	Fall Semester start: early April Spring Semester start: mid-September
Payments (Students must confirm with their host school/university that Smith is responsible for all tuition, room and board expenses)	
Tuition Deposit Required?	No
Accommodation Deposit Covered by Smith?	Yes, covered by Smith. In the interest of time deposit should be paid by the student and reimbursed. Contact Budget Coordinator for refund.
Tuition:	Tuition Invoicing sent directly to Smith.
Accommodation:	Accommodation Invoicing sent directly to Smith. Students may incur additional utility expenses. Student must send documentation to Budget Coordinator for reimbursement.
Accommodation Expectations:	Housing is limited and not guaranteed. Students should apply for GSA-affiliated housing as soon as possible. Housing options include the Blythswood or Margaret Macdonald House and students may elect any room type offered. The Halls are apartment-style clusters of 6-8 single rooms with private (en suite) baths and shared kitchens. Meals are self-catered (you cook your own meals.) If you are unable to receive housing through GSA, be in touch with the Smith Office of International Study immediately. We will need to approve any alternative housing options recommended by the GSA accommodations office.
Accommodation Application Deadline at Glasgow School of Arts:	Apply as soon as your application acceptance offer is received.
Visa:	All students applying directly to host schools/universities will be required to obtain their own visa. It is very important that students begin this process early, as it may take a several months to obtain. This is especially true for International Students.
