Payments (Students must confirm with their host school/university that Smith is responsible for all tuition, room and board expenses)	
Tuition Deposit Required?	No
Accommodation Deposit Covered by Smith?	Yes, covered by Smith. In the interest of time deposit can be paid by the student and reimbursed. Contact Budget Coordinator for refund. Or you can contact the Budget Coordinator with your Hallpad login information and they can make the payment for you.
Tuition:	Invoice sent directly to Smith in the spring before enrollment.
Accommodation:	Students must forward on the email they receive from LSE regarding accommodation payments. Student must submit LSE user name and password to the Budget Coordinator so that payments can be processed online.
Accommodation Expectations:	Housing guaranteed only if you apply within the posted deadlines. Students may choose standard or single rooms in LSE residence halls with 31 or 39 week contracts. The halls will offer either shared or private (en suite) bathrooms and self-catered (cook your own meals) or catered housing. Smith will not support studio or townhouse-style room options.
Accommodation Application Deadline at London School of Economics (LSE) (UK):	May 31st
Visa:	All students applying directly to host schools/universities will be required to obtain their own visa. It is very important that students begin this process early, as it may take a several months to obtain. This is especially true for International Students.
