Tuition Deposit Required?	No
Accommodation Deposit Covered by Smith?	Yes, covered by Smith. In the interest of time deposit should be paid by the student and reimbursed. Contact Budget Coordinator for refund.
Tuition:	Tuition Invoicing sent separately directly to Smith.
Accommodation:	Invoice may be sent to Smith or directly to the student. Student must forward it on to the Budget Coordinator.
Accommodation Expectations:	<p>Housing is not guaranteed for single semester students. Students may choose from any of the residence halls affiliated with the University of Manchester. You will be able to select single rooms, with either shared or private (en suite) bathrooms, and catered (meal plan) or self-catered (you cook your own meals) dining plans. In choosing a residence hall, consider its location in relation to your primary campus.</p> <p>If you are unable to receive housing through Manchester, be in touch with the Smith Office of International Study immediately. We will need to approve any alternative housing options recommended by the accommodations office.</p>
Accommodation Application Deadline at University of Manchester:	Housing applications should be filed as soon as possible after your acceptance offer is received.
Visa:	<p>All students applying directly to host schools/universities will be required to obtain their own visa.</p> <p>It is very important that students begin this process early, as it may take a several months to obtain. This is especially true for International Students. We recommend students use a service, such as, Perry International www.perryvisa.com</p>
