Tuition:	Invoice may be sent to Smith or directly to the student. Student must forward it on to the Budget Coordinator.
Accommodation:	Invoice may be sent to Smith or directly to the student. Student must forward it on to the Budget Coordinator.
Accommodation Expectations:	Housing is not guaranteed. Students may apply for single or shared rooms in any undergraduate housing: we recommend either the Kooloobong Village or the International House options. Options may include either a full meal plan or a kitchenette for preparation of your own meals. Smith will not approve studio or 1-3 bedroom apartment options. If you are unable to receive housing through Wollongong, be in touch with the Smith Office of International Study immediately. We will need to approve any alternative housing options recommended by Wollongong.
Accommodation Application Deadline at University of Wollongong:	Apply as soon as possible once your application offer has been received.
Visa:	All students applying directly to host schools/universities will be required to obtain their own visa. It is very important that students begin this process early, as it may take a several months to obtain. This is especially true for International Students.
